#### 4. New Business

- a. Motion 1: Installing the Crown Logo at Queens and Moody Park ice. Motion: Shawn Lakusta; 2<sup>nd</sup>: Ron Connor. Carried.
- b. Banner Update Vandy. Explanation of criteria and process for putting banners up at MPA and QPA.
- 5.1 President report Ross Young. Thank you to everyone all volunteer positions are important and appreciated. Planning to return.
- 5.2 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Rob Nasato. Responsibilities revolve around web site and fundraising. We sold 900 tickets for the Giants game this year, plus raised about \$4500 in 50/50 sales. Updating the web site regularly. Looking at adding "team web site" links to the NWMHA web site. Planning to return.
- 5.3 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Purn Disanjh. Main responsibility is for the tournaments. The Christmas Midget tournaments each had 8 teams entered in them we ran both an "A" level and a "C" level tournament. The Bobby Love (Atom) and Al Hughes Tournaments run at Spring Break. - 5.8 Ref-in Chief Mirko Dabic. Absent. Report given by Ross: enjoyed working with the kids. Planning to return.
- 5.9 Equipment Manager Kevin Woolley. Doesn't need to purchase any equipment most kids seem to be coming with their own. Tried to sell-off stuff that's been sitting on the racks for a few years. Will be ordering about 47 new red (12% attrition rate). Would like to purchase more white sets. Planning to purchase "C" and "A" letters. A lot of damage done to jerseys because of using tape for the letters. Thank you to Ron and Mark for the improvements on the equipment room. Planning to get rid of some old jerseys. Planning to return.
- 5.10 Ice Allocator Lynda Callard. Year went relatively well, considering it was her first. Expects that it will be easier next year. Planning to return.
- 5.11 Referee Allocator Jennifer Borrowman. Pretty good season. Mirko and she are making some changes to help the refs. Planning to return.
